○ **OLYMPIC SITE SURVEILLANCE UPGRADE**

There will be far superior security in the near future at the Sydney Olympic Park as a result of TPE's latest project.

Sydney Olympic Park Authority (SOPA), which is responsible for managing and developing the 640-hectare site, has commissioned TPE to install the latest digital video management software and hardware to 140 cameras located at the Homebush site.

TPE has been involved in providing electro technology solutions for SOPA since 1999, with major projects involving CCTV, fibre optic cabling, PA, security, intercom and access control.

The new DVtel Video Management Software would replace the existing digital video recorders and analogue matrix switchers.

The upgrade will improve the storage time of the video recording to three months and will also provide CCTV live viewing and playback functions on one platform for the first time.

While many may think Sydney Olympic Park is only used for sporting events and the Royal Easter Show, SOPA's long-term vision is to develop a dynamic and diverse township for commercial, leisure, education, retail, hotel and cultural uses supporting 20,000 workers.

Two residential sites incorporating 1,300 apartments, or nearly 3,000 residents, are also part of the master plan.
